

New homes for North Cotabato IPs

Fifty (50) Teduray families are thankful for their new homes in Datu Sandigan Village Ph1, Brgy. Bato Bato, President Roxas, North Cotabato.

Former Informal Settler Families (ISFs) living along the municipality's river banks, road right-of-ways, and water shed protected areas, the Manobo (indigenous people) moved into their new homes last September 8, 2016 during the turn-over ceremonies between the NHA Region 12, National Commission on Indigenous People (NCIP) and the Local Government Unit of President Roxas headed by Mayor Jaime Mahimpit.

Expect fifty (50) more housing units programmed for construction for Phase 2 construction.

In a related story, fifty (50) more Bagobo Tagabawa (indigenous peoples) families from North Cotabato received their Certificate to Occupy their new homes in Balangas Community IP Housing Project located at Purok 6, Brgy., Batasan Makilala North Cotabato.

During the turnover ceremonies held on October 7, 2016, NHA Kidapawan District Manager, Engr. Zenaida M. Cabiles encouraged the Bagobo Tagabawa beneficiaries to take care of their new homes. Further, she reiterated to the Makilala LGU that NHA also caters to the housing needs of informal settler families.
