

President Duterte Leads Groundbreaking of Two Housing Projects

DAVAO CITY – President Rodrigo Roa Duterte led the groundbreaking ceremonies for two housing projects on May 19, 2017 in his home city of Davao.

Biyaya ng Pagbabago, located in Brgy. Los Amigos, Tugbok District, Davao City, is a joint multi-sectoral project of the National Housing Authority (NHA), the Local Government of Davao, San Miguel Corporation, and Pilipinong May Puso Foundation.

On the other hand, located in Brgy. Talomo, Davao City, is the Madayaw Residences – a project under NHA's flagship program for the uniformed personnel of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the Philippine National Police (PNP).

The 8.67-hectare Biyaya ng Pagbabago Project, aims to generate a total of 908 residential units and 2 commercial lots to benefit Informal Settler Families (ISFs). Meanwhile, the Madayaw Residences is pegged to house 16 5-storey low-rise buildings (LRB) with floor areas of 42 sqm and 24 sqm.
