**HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Implemented the following livelihood and affordability enhancement programs / projects in 27 Northville Sites, 15 Southville sites and 7 Non-rail Sites:

**I. RESETTLEMENT CUM LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM**

- a. Facilitated the conduct of various technical skills training cum production / employment, capability trainings/seminars/orientations to a total of **79,723 beneficiaries**

- b. **Referral of 52,768** job seekers to various companies for possible job placement generated a total of **23,421 jobs** for NHA beneficiaries. They were employed as factory workers, OFW, service crews, construction workers, and others
- c. Facilitated extension of **credit assistance** to **25,703 loan grantees**. Beneficiaries who were given loan assistance engaged in small businesses like sari-sari store, handicraft, tailoring, vending, buy and sell business, and others.
- d. Granted **scholarship** for technical trainings to **4,383 beneficiaries** through tie-up with TESDA and other agencies / LGUs offering scholarship grants
- e. Provided technical assistance on organizing and registration with Cooperative Development Authority to **29 cooperatives** providing services along:

water system - 3 coops

transport services -2 coops

credit services – 7 coops

producer coop– 1 coop

consumer coop– 3 coops

multi-purpose coop- 13 coops

- f. Made tie-ups with various agencies for **provision of different grants** (decorticating machine, sewing machines, TODA tools and equipment, starter kits, and operating capital) to a total of **3,837 beneficiaries**
- g. Facilitated conduct of agri-related cum production trainings to **9,019 beneficiaries** through tie up with the Department of Agriculture and Ginintuang Ugat Enterprises (for vetiver propagation).
- h. 651 beneficiaries were provided subsidies in exchange of community work (vetiver propagation, communal gardening, bamboo planting, solid waste management) through the NHA-DSWD Cash for Building Livelihood Assets (CBLA) program.
- i. Generated **livelihood home-based projects** and assisted **7,225 beneficiaries**. Also, engaged **1,800 beneficiaries** in **subcontracting jobs** like Christmas lights assembly, handicraft rattan, rug-making, paper bag assemble, and others)
- j. Organized **77 work / production guilds** with a total of **3,925 members**

## **II. IMPOK PABAHAY PROGRAM (IPP)**

- a. Total number of IPP saver-enrollees in Northville and Southville project sites, Bagong Silang Resettlement Project, Smokey Mountain Development and Resettlement Project, District IV, East Sector, Cebu and Tacloban is **11,972**
- b. Total amount saved and paid to NHA from these project sites is **PhP44.57M**
