Rosemarie Edillon is the current Undersecretary for National Development Policy and Planning at the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA).

Among her major responsibilities is shepherding the formulation of the Philippine Development Plan (PDP). The PDP is an elaboration of the country's priorities over the medium-term and is the blueprint of government policies, programs and projects. She also oversees the monitoring of the PDP implementation. In addition, she is in charge of providing technical advice on policy issues to both the legislative and executive branches of government, especially the committees of the NEDA Board.

Usec. Edillon currently chairs the Task Group on Recovery under the National Task Force against COVID19; she also chairs the Technical Working Group on Anticipatory and Forward Planning and a member of the sub-TWG on Data Analytics under the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases.

Usec Edillon holds a PhD in Economics from La Trobe University in Australia, an MA degree in Economics from the University of the Philippines (UP) School of Economics, and an MS degree in Statistics from the UP School of Statistics.
